

Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Special Council Meeting

Lexington, Kentucky    August 19, 2008

The Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, Kentucky convened in special session on August 19, 2008 at 6:00 P.M. Present were Council Member Ellinger in the chair presiding in the absence of Mayor Newberry, and the following members of the Council: Council Members McChord, Myers, Stevens, Stinnett, Beard, Blevins, Blues, Crosbie, DeCamp, and James. Absent were Council Members Gorton, Gray, Henson and Lane.

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An Ordinance changing the zone from a Professional Office (P-1) zone to a Downtown Frame Business (B-2A) zone for 0.16 net (0.19 gross) acre, and from a Planned Neighborhood Residential (R-3) zone to a Downtown Frame Business (B-2A) zone for 0.24 net (0.42 gross) acre, for properties located at 522-528 East Main Street and 109 Kentucky Avenue, subject to certain use restrictions imposed as conditions of granting the zone change. Mr. Ellinger explained the procedure and swore in the witnesses.

Mr. Dick Murphy, attorney for the applicant, stated that the applicant and the objectors had reached an agreement on the matter.

Ms. Rush Scott, Kentucky Ave., stated that she affirmed that an agreement had been reached between herself and the applicant.

There was discussion as to whether the public hearing had to be held if the objector, Ms. Scott, withdrew her objection to the requested zone change.

Ms. Scott stated that she withdrew her objection.

Mr. Askew stated that the ordinance could be voted upon.

Upon motion of Mr. DeCamp, seconded by Mr. McChord, the Ordinance was approved by the following vote:
